Staff Report:

Recent events include Community Art days in Bishop and Independence. Great community turn-out and participation by other organizations/non-profits. Other events include the Labor Day Arts and Crafts show in the Bishop City Park on September 1-4th.

Erin attended back to school nights in Bishop, Big Pine and Lone Pine. She will be attending the Owens Valley School on Sept. 7th. She got approximately 30 sign-ups for new volunteer docents. She's currently coordinating with ICSOS and will be attending school staff meetings to advocate for additional teachers to use the Brummitt-Taylor classical music program in their classrooms. She also designed a new brochure to distribute to teachers and parents. The brochures highlight all of our programs available to students with the hopes of expanded participation in all classrooms in Inyo County.

Ryan and Lynn continue to focus mostly on the Millpond Music festival. All performers are scheduled for main stage and workshops, and have received their performer packets. Sound for both stages is set. The reception for educators is set and wristbands are being distributed. Food and artist vendors are set. Kids activities are set, and we've expanded the offerings with the addition of Lindsey Hughes from ICSOS – focus on physical activity. We will be offering assemblies in four schools on Friday and Monday. Leslie Chapman has spear-headed the task of using mobile credit card readers. Advertising is contracted. Program and t-shirts are close to being done. Ticket and camping sales are good. We are still recruiting volunteers, getting close to complete. We've distributed tickets to members, sponsors, all five Native American Tribes, and staff and residents of Progress House.
