Staff report: Recent events include Community Art days in Bishop and Independence. Great community participation by other organizations/non-profits. Other events include the Labor Day Arts and Crafts show, the Millpond Music Festival, and a concert with David Jacobs-Strain. Upcoming events include a new featured artist show in the gallery and reception for the show, and participation in the Chocolate Art Walk on October 28th. Spellbinder Books is holding a book signing event here on October 20th.

Activity in our space by others include new sewing classes by Heather Freeman, 2 days by Palisades Glacier High School for their annual talent show, and on-going yoga and Zumba classes.

Erin attended back to school nights in Bishop, Big Pine, Lone Pine and Independence in August and September. She had approximately 30 sign-ups for new volunteer docents.

She's currently coordinating with ICSOS and will be attending school staff meetings to advocate for additional teachers to use the Brummitt-Taylor classical music program in their classrooms.

She also designed a new brochure for teachers and parents. The brochures highlight all programs available to students with the hopes of expanded participation in all classrooms in Inyo County.

The California Arts Council recently approved the 2017-2018 CAC-SLP funding. Additionally they are going to fund an additional 9 months to get the program back on a June 30th timeline.
