Inyo Council for the Arts (ICA), in collaboration with the County of Inyo and California Arts Council, is again presenting a series of **Community Art Days** across Inyo County. These four “mini-festivals” will take place in public parks in Lone Pine, Independence, Big Pine, and Bishop, and will feature art activities for all ages, live music throughout the day, workshops, and art and food vendors drawn from each community.

We would like to invite your organization to host a booth at these events. These events will be heavily promoted, and we hope to draw participants of all ages from each of the four communities. While your booth will be an opportunity to promote your organization and share your mission with attendees, we also aim to keep the events centered on the practice and appreciation of the arts. As such, we ask that each booth include a hands-on art or craft activity throughout the afternoon. This activity will ideally be an expression of your organization’s unique culture, mission, and/or relationship to our area. Activities for all ages are encouraged. If you don’t think your organization is able to provide an art activity, please let us know and we may be able to help design one and assist with supplies.

Notes:

- Dates for the first two events are **October 13th in Bishop** and **October 14th in Lone Pine**.
- Booth and activity hours will be 12:00-5:00pm, with an evening concert from 5:00-6:00pm.
- Please bring your own shade tent and table if possible. If your organization does not have a tent and table please let us know, as we have a limited number available to lend for these events.
- Electricity will not be available at your tent.

Community Art Days - 2018

1. In granting this full and complete release and waiver of liability, I specifically waive California Civil Code Section 1542, which states:
