Labor Day Weekend Arts & Crafts Show
Friday, Saturday, Sunday & Monday
August 29 - September 1, 2025

This four-day show of handcrafted arts and crafts is held annually at the Bishop City Park. Bishop is located at the eastern edge of the beautiful Sierra Nevada on Highway 395, about 270 miles north of Los Angeles, and 200 miles south of Reno, Nevada. This show runs in conjunction with the annual Tri-County Fair and draws an estimated 5,000 people to the area. The lovely creek-side park attracts many visitors and keeps shoppers lingering at our shows.

Please carefully review all information provided.

ALL APPLICANTS:

1. **Electricity is not available at your booth, with the exception of a few prepared food vendors.**
2. You are required to send at least two photos of your work with your application if you are a new applicant or if your booth configuration or product has changed significantly. Also, enclose your R.V. space request (if required), payment, and the Release of Liability form.
3. The selection committee will notify you of your entry approval, but a deposited check or credit card charge is a sign of acceptance. In the event your application has not been accepted, your check will be returned or your credit card will not be charged. Booth assignment and R.V. passes are provided upon approval of participation.
4. *If you fail to meet these requirements, or to complete legibly all of the forms, your application will be returned.* A checklist is provided.

FOOD VENDORS:

All food items must meet the criteria of the Inyo County Health Department. If your items are packaged, they *must* be labeled with weight, identification of contents, and names of licensed producers. Vendors will be subject to Inyo County inspection. ***Please note, food vendors MUST fill out a separate application directly with the Inyo County Environmental Health Office for a temporary food license. GENERAL INFORMATION

BOOTHS: The fee is **\$175 for one space measuring 12 ft x 12 ft.** Each participant must supply his or her own display. Booths must include a canopy or tent; tables with storage underneath must have a table skirt and weights (it can get very windy here). Booths should be clean and professional looking. Electricity is not available in your booth. Per City of Bishop ordinance, there are NO dogs allowed in the park, with the exception of service animals as defined by the ADA. Any vendors who bring dogs to the park may be asked to leave and no refund will be issued.

CRITERIA FOR ENTRIES: Items displayed and for sale **must be 75% handcrafted by the vendor.** Any market or mass-produced items are unacceptable and may not be sold at this show. The spirit of this show is that you are selling arts and crafts made by yourself.

SET UP TIME: This outdoor show is held in the Bishop City Park, on the north end of Main Street (Hwy 395) in Bishop. No vendors are allowed to drive on the grass while setting up. You may drive as close as possible to your space on the service road, unload, and move your car to a parking area before setting up your booth. (We will include a park map with your acceptance letter.)

Hours will be:

Thursday (Set-up)	Set-up <u>after ALL spaces are marked</u> , approximately 2:00 p.m.
Friday (Set-up)	Set-up continues; please move vehicle by 9 a.m.- selling hours are 9 a.m. through 6:00 p.m.
Saturday	9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
Sunday	9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
Monday	9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Vendors are expected to stay until the end of the show.

SECURITY: Each participant is responsible for the safety, protection, and insurance of his or her own exhibit and merchandise. Security guards will be on duty each night from 6:30 p.m. to 6:00 a.m., however protection against theft is not guaranteed.

REFUNDS: **Cancellations through August 16th of the current show year will be refunded, minus a \$75 cancellation/processing fee.** *No refunds will be made on accepted and processed applications after August 16th.*

LODGING: A list of motels and local campsites is available at www.bishopvisitor.com or by phoning the Bishop Chamber of Commerce: 760-873-8405. **A limited number of RV/trailer spaces, which have no hook-ups, will be available behind the park for a fee of \$75.00 for the five-day period** (Thursday, Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Monday nights). Please see attached RV and Trailer Parking Application.
No tent camping.

SPECIAL EMPHASIS: Giving on-site demonstrations of your skills is encouraged. Showing people the process of your craft helps them to develop a deeper appreciation for the arts and for the artists who are exhibiting. It also has been shown to improve sales.

BOOTH LOCATION: ***Inyo Council for the Arts cannot guarantee requested booth locations, except for crafters who request their previous year booth space and submit their application and payment by July 1.*** Every effort will be made to assign booth locations as requested. In general, spaces are assigned as applications come in, so earlier requests are more likely to be successful in procuring a specific site.
